INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANT'S REPORT

To the Board of County Commissioners Suwannee County, Florida

We have examined the Suwannee County, Florida's (the County) compliance with Section 218.415, Florida Statutes, regarding the investment of public funds during the year ended September 30, 2016. We have also examined the Clerk of the Circuit Court's (Clerk's) compliance with Section 28.35, 28.36 and 61.181 Florida Statutes during the fiscal year ended September 30, 2016.

We also examined the County's compliance with section 365.172(10) Florida Statutes and requirements specified by the E911 Board grant and special disbursement programs. These laws require that E911 fee revenues, interest, and E911 grant funding to be used to pay for authorized expenditures as specified in the Statutes.

Management is responsible for the County's and Clerk's respective compliance with those requirements. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the County's and the Clerk's compliance based on our examinations.

Our examinations were conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and, accordingly, included examining, on a test basis, evidence about the County's and the Clerk's compliance with those respective requirements and performing such other procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances. We believe that our examinations provide a reasonable basis for our opinion. Our examinations do not provide a legal determination on the County's and the Clerk's compliance with specified requirements.

In our opinion, Suwannee County, Florida and the Suwannee County Clerk of the Circuit Court complied, in all material respects, with the aforementioned requirements for the year ended September 30, 2016.
